
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Town of Randolph Sanitary Sewer System Improvements project. The funding would be used for the construction of various upgrades to the Town's wastewater treatment facility (WWTF), including the addition of effluent disinfection and the replacement of various antiquated assets.
