
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Cuba Memorial Hospital Boiler Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for the project is the Cuba Memorial Hospital located at 140 West Main Street, Cuba, NY 14727. This funding will be used to replace Cuba Memorial Hospital's aging boiler system, ensuring reliable heating, hot water, and HVAC systems that are critical to patient safety, infection control, and uninterrupted healthcare services for the surrounding rural community. It is a responsible use of taxpayer funds because it prevents critical system failures that could disrupt care, protects access to essential healthcare services in a medically underserved area, and strengthens the long-term reliability of this vital community provider in a cost-effective way.
