I am requesting funding for FeedMore WNY in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is FeedMore WNY, located at 100 James E Casey Dr. Buffalo, NY 14206. The funding would be used to build FeedMore WNY's consolidated campus. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because FeedMore WNY has purchased a 74-acre parcel of land in Hamburg, NY, the geographical center of the four counties they serve, and they have turned away around 1 million pounds of food each year from a lack of storage and space to repack and store large donations.
