
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Village of Fredonia for Water System Improvement Regional Interconnection in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive the funding for this project is the Village of Fredonia located at 911 Church Street, Fredonia, New York 14063. The funding would be useful for interconnecting Fredonia's water distribution system with the Town of Pomfret and the North Chautauqua County Water District through new piping, pressure-reducing valves, treatment facilities, and improvements to the Vineyard Drive Pump Station. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve drinking water reliability and quality, support regional water system resilience, and protect public health by ensuring a safe and sustainable water supply for residents and businesses.
